



Creative Ed International's Creative Arts Festival Rules

Welcome to Creative Ed International's Creative Arts Competition! To ensure a smooth and fair competition for all participants, please review and adhere to the following rules:

1. **Performance Duration:** All live performance acts, including setup and takedown of props, equipment, and instruments, must not exceed 4.5 minutes in total. This time limit will be strictly enforced to maintain a fair competition schedule.
2. **Artwork Specifications:** All submitted artwork must not exceed the dimensions of 1 metre by 1 metre (1m x 1m). Artwork that exceeds these dimensions will not be eligible for entry.
3. **Submission Deadline:** Artwork must be submitted to the competition venue no later than Saturday, March 2, 2024. Late submissions will not be accepted.
4. **Backstage Access:** Access to backstage areas will be restricted to participant and chaperone wristband holders only. Unauthorised individuals are not permitted in these areas for safety and security reasons.
5. **Auditorium and Gallery Access:** The auditorium and gallery viewing areas will be open exclusively to spectator ticket holders and chaperone wristband holders. Please ensure you have the appropriate tickets or wristbands to access these areas.
6. **Fair Play and Sportsmanship:** All participants are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship and respectful behaviour at all times. Disruptive or unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification.
7. **Safety Precautions:** Participants are responsible for the safe setup and operation of any props, equipment, or instruments used during live performances. Please ensure that all safety measures are in place.
8. **Equipment Responsibility:** Participants are responsible for their own equipment and instruments. The competition organisers are not liable for any loss, damage, or theft of personal property. All props, instruments are to be set up and taken off stage by the participants within the 4.5 mins time allocation.
9. **Judging Criteria:** Judging will be based on a set of predetermined criteria, which will be made available to participants prior to the competition. Please review these criteria to understand how your performance or artwork will be evaluated.
10. **Disqualification:** Participants who violate any of these rules may be subject to disqualification from the competition at the discretion of the organisers.

11. Decision of the Judges: All decisions made by the judges are final and binding. There will be no appeals or disputes allowed regarding the judges' scores or decisions.

By participating in the Creative Arts Competition, you agree to abide by these rules and regulations. We are committed to providing a fair and enjoyable experience for all participants and spectators.
